 Italy, Romania and Slovakia have requested support from the European Commission under Regulation (EU) 2017/825 on the establishment of the Structural Reform Support Programme ("SRSP Regulation").

- The general objective of this Action is to contribute to the improvement of the efficiency of the health systems in Italy, Romania and Slovakia in order to enhance cohesion and sustainable growth....
- The <u>specific objective</u> of this action is that Italy, Romania and Slovakia extend coverage and effectiveness of colorectal cancer screening programmes and contribute to a reduction in the burden of cancer on the population.

 The final beneficiaries of the Action are Ministries of Health in Italy, Romania and Slovakia, which will profit from improved capacity to design and carry out screening programmes and their organisational models.

Italia

- Selection of effective strategies in Piedmont and Tuscany Lazio and Sicily.
 - aimed to increase participation among nonattendees in the local screening programmes
 - tailored reminder letters according to the principles of "behavioural economics".
 - the offer of alternative tests, tailored to patients' preferences

Italia

- Training of managers and senior officials in Sicily
 - a PRECEDE—PROCEED model approach will be used to identify barriers to screening and to assess strategies favouring uptake, which remains relatively low.
- Retraining of health professionals in Lazio and Sicily
 - retraining courses for endoscopists and for pathologists
